

# Do Not Pack List



## Attention Customer: THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ALLOWED FOR TRANSPORT\*:

It is illegal for a carrier to transport hazardous materials or restricted items regulated by the federal government. These items are capable of posing an unreasonable risk to health, safety, and property when transported in commerce. Hazardous materials are items that are flammable, explosive, combustibile, corrosive, poisonous, infectious, or radioactive. These hazardous and restricted items include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Acids of any kind
- Adhesives of any kind
- Aerosol Cans
- Alcohol/Wine
- Ammonia
- Ammunition and gun powders
- Anti-freeze
- Batteries\*\* (Wet, Nonspillable, Dry, Lithium)
- Battery Packs, Battery Chargers
- Bleach
- Butane Tanks
- Camping equipment (camping stove, kerosene lanterns)
- Candles
- Carbonated Drinks
- Charcoal Briquettes
- Chemicals
- Cleaners
- Disinfectants
- Dry Ice
- Essential oils (flammable)
- Explosives
- Fertilizer compounds
- Fire Extinguishers
- Firearms (undeclared or loaded)
- Fireworks
- Firewood
- Gasoline/gas cans
- Hand sanitizer
- Hover Boards

\*\*A carrier may ship "smaller" size lithium cells and batteries as follows: (a) "Lithium Ion" Cells equal to or less than 20Wh; and Batteries equal to or less than 100Wh, or for highway ONLY: Cells equal to or less than 1g; and Batteries equal to or less than 2g. (b) "Lithium Metal" Cells equal to or less than 1g; and Batteries equal to or less than 2g, or for highway ONLY: Cells not exceeding 5g; and Batteries not exceeding 25g. However, you must inform the carrier of each such item included in your shipment and must properly package them.

**IMPORTANT:** It is your responsibility to know whether your household goods shipment contains hazardous materials. Be sure to identify any hazards before your shipment is packed and remove them. You may refer to the Hazardous Materials Table (see 49 C.F.R. § 172.101) listing all items designated by the Department of Transportation.

Your mover is not able to move personal, important, and sentimental items, including, but not limited to, the items listed below. These items will not be covered under the valuation coverage. These items should be moved by you! Please put them in a safe place prior to pack day so they are not inadvertently packed by your mover.
